The French Association for Natural Disaster Risk reduction (AFPCN), was created in 2001 in the continuity of the French Committee of the International Decade for the Prevention of Natural Disasters.



> AFPCN IS PART OF THE NATIONAL PLATFORM FOR DISASTER RISK REDUCTION (DRR) and promoting links between civil society, experts for natural disaster risk reduction and the French government

> AFPCN CO-LEADS THE ORIENTATION COUNCIL FOR THE PREVENTION OF MAJOR NATURAL RISKS (COPRNM) in close collaboration with the General Director for Risk Prevention of the Ministry of Ecological and Solidarity Transition

> AFPCN COORDINATES THE USERS' COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL OBSERVATORY OF NATURAL RISKS (CU-ONRN)

AFPCN is networking many members and partners such as local authorities, public institutions, universities and research centers, NGO's, companies, experts, national and local elected representatives, students, central or local administrative officials.

Membership in AFPCN is open to all individuals and organizations involved in disaster risk reduction in France or abroad. It gives the opportunity to be involved in working groups, workshops or conferences enhancing a pluridisciplinary approach and the links between professionals of different sectors; It is also encouraging debates and exchanges around DRR and thus is contributing to the efficiency of public policy.

4 main DRR themes:

THEME 1 – NATIONAL NETWORKING ACTIVITIES



- INVOLVEMENT IN THE DESIGN, ANIMATION AND VALORISATION OF THE NATIONAL CONFERENCES ON NATURAL RISKS (Assises nationales des risques naturels); 2019 in Montpelllier, and 2016 in Marseilles
- DEVELOPMENT AND ANIMATION OF A COLLABORATIVE INTELLIGENCE PLATFORM to promote exchanges between disaster risk reduction professionals



- DRIVING THE USERS' COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL OBSERVATORY OF NATURAL RISKS and supporting the creation of a future database on harmful events
- PARTICIPATION IN THE NATIONAL FLOOD COMMISSION (Commission mixte inondation) whose one of the main goals is to assess and to apply national PAPI (Programmes d'actions de prévention des inondations) label to flood prevention actions programs

THEME 2 – RESEARCH AND PROSPECTIVE (Scientific Council)



The purpose of the Scientific Council is to enable a better analysis, understanding, and appropriation of disaster risk reduction topics by bringing together independent experts from various disciplines (natural sciences and engineering, medical sciences, social sciences and societal sciences) thanks to thematic working groups and conferences to produce and communicate deliverables on current topics.

THEME 3 –TERRITORIAL ACTIONS



In order to set up concrete activities applied in the field, and to make the connection between public policy and territorial reality AFPCN supervises local working groups such as:

DISASTERS FEEDBACKS

Co-piloted by NGO <u>CYPRES</u>, this group is offering to communities a tool for collecting, managing and sharing REX data.

O TERRITORIAL VULNERABILITY AND RESILIENCE

Co-animated with NGO <u>IMdR</u>, this group is assessing network vulnerability to major risks and defining a methodology and action plans to increases networks resilience by using a preventive approach in two French agglomerations - pilot sites (Le Havre and Grand Troyes).





O TOURISM AND RISKS

This group is aiming to raise awareness among municipalities and citizens to the occurrence and consequences of natural hazards in tourist areas.

 CONSTRUCTION OF AN INTERPROFESSIONAL NETWORK "B3 FRANCE" -BUILD BACK BETTER FRANCE initiated with the organization of the conference "What contributions of insurance actors to make and rebuild better" in September 2017



 TRAINING COURSES ON "TERRITORIAL SAFEGUARDING PLANS" (plans communaux de sauvegarde - PCS) organized in collaboration with the Ministry of the Interior, in order to create an exchanges platform between local elected representatives of small municipalities, to collect their know-how and share their feedback on local risks and the implementation of PCS

THEME 4 – EUROPEAN AND INTERNATIONAL ACTIONS



- PARTICIPATION OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL RISK ACTORS AT THE UNISDR Global Platform Conferences
- CO-ANIMATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE OF COPRNM set up to promote the coordination of French actors working in the field of disaster risk reduction in Europe or internationally.
- VALORIZATION FRENCH KNOW-HOW THROUGH EXCHANGES WITH INTERNATIONAL NETWORKS OF RESEARCH AND PRACTITIONERS IN THE FIELD OF DRR such as <u>IDRIM Society</u> (Integrated Disaster Risk Management)





Chairmanship

Board of Directors

Its governance is based on a Delegate general Henri LEGRAND, a Secretary general Roland NUSSBAUM, a Bureau and a Board of Directors comprising representatives of various partner institutions such as AFPS, ANEB, ANEL, BRGM, CEPRI, CEREMA, CMI, IAU IdF, IMdR, IRSTEA, Météo France, and MRN.























Scientific Council

Project managers
